- Shorts (except for swimming)
- Earrings
- Bracelets
- Necklaces
- Body-pierced jewelry
- Sleeveless Shirts or Tank Tops
- Sagging Pants

DRESS CODE FOR LADIES

Swimming

- One Piece Bathing Suit

Athletics

- Modest, knee-length culottes & modest tops

Services (teens)

- Modest, knee-length skirts & dresses
- Appropriate top

Ladies Should NOT Wear

- Pants, shorts, gauchos, walking shorts and capris
- Tight-fitting or low cut clothing
- Sleeveless tops, cropped tops, or sun dresses

*All skirts, dresses, and culottes MUST come to the bottom of the knee.

CODE OF CONDUCT

- No alcohol, tobacco, or drugs
- No radios, tape or CD players, ipods or mp3 players
- No video games or playing cards
- No guns, knives or weapons of any kind
- No cell phones
- No fireworks
- No clothing with questionable or inappropriate advertising, logos, designs, or messages
- No magazines
- No physical contact allowed between male and female campers
- No mixed swimming
